Well guys,a bit of an update on the drive with more specific times and dates of where the separate groups can meet before the run. If there are problems with the links I have posted please let me know and I will try correct them. When I looked at the map this evening it seems to have changed from how I had it set, so if you already uploaded / saved or likewise please check to see if your version is ok.

Travel lodge Blanchardstown leaving at 10am

Globe retail park N7 Naas exit at leaving at 10am.

Citywest shopping centre leaving at 10.15

Blue Gardinia leaving at 10.30 to start the run.

From there we will head to Blessington and let anybody who forgot to fill up with some normal none super duper go go juice and onward as shown on the google map link.

We will stop first at the Turlough Hill car park about 30 minutes after the fuel stop.

From there to Laragh and at Lynhams pub turn right towards Rathdrum, then Avoca, Woodenbridge, Aughrim, then stopping for a bite to eat in Rathwood which is right beside "The chocolate garden of Ireland" for those that need to get bonus / browney points

Onwards then to Tullow, Carlow then Athy via a road right adjacent to the Barrow.

Then turning right towards Kilcullen.
