I did some research when was polishing my 2 intake manifold. In the end came to conclusion not to lacquer or coat it due to pain in the arse to remove lacquer if it gets chip,scratch. The easiest way is to keep on top of it and polish it once in a while. Most of the pastes would contain agents that help metal to oxidize, keep an eye out for that. If we're talking about cheaper prolonged treatment on polished surface the best is some sort of wax that's as pure as possible without solvents or petroleum stuff.
