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in engine bay diagnostics port short out t1 and e1 that will show if you have any error codes, But usually the solenoid sticks, turning ignition on and off a few times quickly frees it up. Its located in the frunk on passenger side a little round solenoid thing pretty much just over where you top up the power steering fluid.
