Yeah pretty expensive stuff. Although recently I found that I've got some strange wiring issue relating to my ISC. There is a black/yellow wire in the engine bay that provides 12v to a lot of the vsv's etc. I've found that mine is 12v with the ISC unplugged and then 7v (or sometimes less) with it plugged in.

My cold start has always been a problem so I am wondering if my ISC is grounding out due to a bad coil or something..
